**LOCATION:** Nonsuch Island, Castle Harbour  
Daily fieldtrips to explore different habitats including Spittal Pond, Paget Marsh, North Rock, Hungry Bay, Walsingham and Harrington Sound.

**GOAL:** To provide students with an awareness of the uniqueness and fragility of Bermuda's natural environment.  
The course is also an introduction to biological and environmental fieldwork, designed to help students make future course and career choices.

**COST:** \$200 all inclusive. The camp is subsidised by Catlin Insurance and PartnerRe. Financial assistance is available, so do not let cost deter you attending.

**OPEN TO:** Students aged 15-18 (must be 15 by 1 January 2016) with a strong interest in the environment, biology and/or geography.
